The Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA) has an on-going construction program and will be advertising for bids on various construction projects. This program includes both building construction and civil work at Orlando International Airport and Orlando Executive Airport. The construction values of the individual projects are estimated to be between \$250,000 and \$35 million.

For federally funded construction projects, GOAA has adopted a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Policy. For non-federally funded construction projects, GOAA has adopted a Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) Policy and a Local Developing Business Enterprises (LDB) Policy. These participation goals will be established by GOAA on a project by project basis.

The below listed projects are scheduled to be advertised and/or bid during the next three months.

BP-418 BAGGAGE HANDLING SYSTEM RENOVATION (Design/Build)

CONSTRUCTION VALUE: Between \$15M and \$50M

ADVERTISE: September 2010 BIDS DUE: January 2011

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of design-build services for the renovation of the Baggage Handling Systems (BHS) at the Landside Terminal at the Orlando International Airport. This project provides for the replacement of the existing 16-pier baggage sort system, currently used by Delta/AirTran/AeroMexico Airlines, with a new 16-pier baggage sort system including the replacement of the ticket counter conveyors serving these new systems. The scope also includes the replacement of the two existing baggage make-up carousels, currently used by United Airlines and British Airlines, and all associated ticket counter conveyors with a new 9-pier baggage sort system. All associated BHS controls and graphics will be consolidated into a single system controlled from the existing Landside Terminal BHS Control Room.
